

October 16 Offshore Steelhead and Salmon

The final trip of the season was yesterday and it was a GREAT day. We finished 13 for 17 with lots of steelhead action. We missed a few fish, and had to toss back two lake trout, but the steelhead kept us entertained. Boxing 9 steelhead and two kings for the table. Northport Nailer spoons in Sunfire, orange ice gold, perch, mashed bannnana, watermelon frost all took fish as well as Atomic Green Glow and Blue moon HorseFlies. Water was flat in the morning and waves increased to sold 3-4 footers for the ride in. We had our best action in 290-315 feet of water. Anything from a 3 color down to 130 on the rigger. No good temp breaks, just a slow steady drop as the riggers went down.
