Good Offshore Action

Fishing offshore in Muskegon is very good. We sat down in 150 and headed out after one pass in the channel with no action. We started getting into fish about 215 feet and continued to about 275. A good mix of Nailers and Horse Flies. Nailers in Grape Tiger (68), Sunfire (69), Superior Sunset (35), Harvinator, Blue Mahi (82), Mashed Bananna (11) all took fish. As well as Sea Mist, Seaweed and Artic Ice flies. Fish were biting anywhere from 4 colors of lead down to 80 on the riggers and 350 copper. High divers 80 back, Wire 185-210. Down speed was 2.4-2.6 again so a bit on the hot side for my boat. As evening fell, we went shallower and did pick away at fish in to about 85 feet while we were pulling lines. We had a mix of kings, lakers and steelhead to about 11 pounds. There are a few larger kings being caught in shallower water, but the fishing is very hit and miss.
