

Fishing is Strong

I continue to be too busy to keep reports updated. So the general bite is really good with strong action early in the morning. Flies have dominated the catch, but plugs are holding their own. Last weekend was three trips in two days. Trip one found me offshore in 330-350 fow and having lots of bites on smaller fish with a few mature kings mixed in. Trip two I stayed closer to home and worked on kings in 170 fow and boxed a 2 man crew. Trip three found me back in 170-200 and working flies on the bottom of the water column. All lures have been in the bottom of the water column and action has been good with roughly 20 bites per trip.

Northport Nailer flies in SeaMist, SeaMist UV, Artic Ice and Little Boy Blue have all been really strong. Pearl glow plugs are picking away at fish as well.
